

## Copyright Information

### Photocopying/Internet Downloading and Recording

Photocopied/internet downloaded music is not permitted at the **Rotary Burlington Music Festival** unless authorized by the publisher or with proof of purchase of internet downloaded music. Participants who bring unauthorized music will be disqualified from receiving any awards and could be disqualified from the class. It is the sole responsibility of the participant to ensure that the score(s) used follow the copyright laws.

Unauthorized recording of performances in any media is not permitted. Refer to the *Copyright Act of Canada* at [www.cb.cda.gc.ca](http://www.cb.cda.gc.ca) for further information.

### FAQ

***How can I obtain permission to photocopy/internet download of an out-of-print selection that I find in a library or receive from a teacher?***

Contact the publisher to request permission to make an authorized photocopy/internet download. Contact information for most publishers can be found online or obtained from a music retailer. Some music retailers can obtain authorized photocopies/internet downloads through a special online service. You may use your teacher's original copy as well.

***Can I photocopy a page of music to facilitate a page turn?***

You may photocopy a single page once you have obtained permission from the publisher. The Frederick Harris Music Co., Limited grants permission to festival, recital and examination participants to photocopy single pages from their publications to facilitate a page turn.

***I have only one original copy of my music; however I need to bring two (three) original copies for the Festival competition. What can I do?***

Participants for voice, string, brass, and woodwind classes must bring two or three original copies of their music to the Festival class: one for the adjudicator, one for the accompanist and perhaps one for the participant. A second (third) original copy of the music could be purchased, or borrowed from other sources such as a music retailer, a teacher or a library.
